AP exams passed with a score of 3 or higher will earn six (6) units of semester credit except where otherwise noted. Exams passed earn a grade of credit (CR) and are not calculated into the GPA. Extension of credit is reviewed annually, and occasionally varies from exam year to exam year, as content, exams and CSUCI curricula are subject to change.
