



## **2010 President's Dinner Raffle Rules and Regulations**

California State University Channel Islands (CI) Foundation, a tax exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (EIN 77-0433230), is conducting this raffle pursuant to California Penal Code Section 320.5, et seq, to raise funds to benefit CI student programs.

### **About our Organization:**

The CI Foundation was established for the purpose of encouraging and accepting private gifts to the University. The mission of the CI Foundation is to support and encourage the University's strategic agenda and institutional mission. The Foundation is the catalyst and conduit through which gifts and endowment income flow to provide immediate and long-term support of the University. The Foundation will also assist the University by creating strong relationships with alumni/ae, friends, and partners in the state of California who seek to use their goodwill and influence for the strengthening of CI's mission and goals. The Foundation, in consideration of receiving recognition as an official auxiliary organization of the California State University, may have oversight of general business ventures in support of the University.

### **Registration with the State of California:**

By letter from the Attorney General's office, CI Foundation has registered with the California Department of Justice under Raffle Registration Number 1680.

### **Prize:**

A stunning piece of jewelry donated by Van Gundy Jewelers. Item cannot be exchanged or redeemed for cash from the jeweler.

### **Eligibility:**

All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply. The raffle is void where prohibited or restricted by laws.

### **Tickets:**

Tickets are \$50.00 each or 3 for \$100.00. The price of the raffle ticket is not a tax-deductible charitable contribution. Only one eligible person may be entered in the raffle per ticket sold. If the name of more than one person is submitted with a ticket purchase, and that ticket is selected as the winning ticket, then the person named first will be deemed the holder of the record of that ticket and declared the winner. Division of prize by a group purchasing a ticket in common shall be the sole responsibility of the person named as the holder of the record of that ticket, should that ticket be selected as the winning ticket.

### **How to Purchase:**

An individual can purchase as many tickets as he or she may wish. To purchase tickets: use the order form provided on the CI website (click on the President's Dinner button) and mail it to CI Foundation, One University Drive, Camarillo, CA 93012 to the attn: Dianne Wei. Be sure to include payment by check or credit card (Visa or MasterCard only). Check should be made payable to CI Foundation. Ticket

receipts (stubs) will be retained for entry in the drawing and the remaining portion of the tick will be mailed back to the purchaser. Tickets may also be purchased in person from CI staff with payment by cash, check or credit card. The ticket receipts (stubs) for in-person purchases should be filled out immediately and returned to the CI representative. By law, tickets cannot be purchased on the CI website or by email. Any entry form submitted by email will be rejected. CI reserves the right to reject any entry form that is submitted with payment that does not constitute "good fund". Prior to the prize drawings, CI will make a reasonable effort to notify any individual who has submitted an entry form that has been rejected for whatever reason. All sales are final. No refunds will be made with the exception of payments received via mail after 5pm on Friday, October 22, 2010. CI assumes no responsibility for lost, late, misdirected or non-delivered mail or any other failure to receive orders or deliver receipts prior to the drawing deadlines.

Tickets will be sold at the President's Dinner event until the end of the reception at which time the drawing close.

**Selection of Winner:**

The raffle drawing will be held on Saturday, October 23, 2010 at the President's Dinner at the Embassy Suites Mandalay Beach – Hotel & Resort in Oxnard. Purchase of a raffle ticket does not gain entry to the President's Dinner. The winner need not be present to win. The winning ticket will be selected by random drawing. The drawing is open to the public. The winner will be notified according to the contact information provided to CI at the time of the ticket purchase. If the prize winner cannot be located by 5:00 p.m. December 23, 2010, after attempting to make contact through the information provided at the time of the purchasing the ticket, such winner will be deemed to have elected to donate the prize to CI.
